NOTE TO MR ATHANASIOS KATSOGIANNIS PRESIDENT OF THE CENTRAL STAFF COMMITTEE

Follow-up on Sysper automation of carry-over of annual leave in cases Subject: of long-term sick leave

Dear Mr Katsogiannis,

Further to the correspondence exchanged in 2022 (1) and 2023 (2) regarding the possibility to automate in Sysper the carry-over of annual leave for staff members on long-term sick leave, I am pleased to inform you that this development has now been successfully implemented.

As from 1 January 2026, the carry-over of annual leave for staff members on long-term sick leave — defined as absences of more than 20 consecutive working days within a calendar year — will be processed automatically in Sysper, without the need for any manual intervention or validation.

This improvement will ensure a fair, transparent and efficient treatment of staff concerned, while reducing the administrative workload for services.

I would like to thank the Central Staff Committee for its continued engagement and constructive dialogue on this matter.
